

Compensation—Equilibrium and Balance

From the White Eagle teachings:

‘The ego is the innermost, the impersonal self. The ego desires lessons. It does not mind how it gets them ... it wants the lessons. This divine urge in each wants to grow and expand, even by and through pain. Compensation is one of the great laws ... one of the five great laws of life.’

‘Why then do the innocent suffer for the guilty? They do not; they only appear to. But the law of cause and effect is exact, just, perfect and true. There is always compensation as a result of suffering.’

‘From the earth point of view, you see terrible physical suffering, but remember, there is compensation in soul growth.’

‘There is something within every soul, no matter who it is, there is God within every man and woman, like to an urge or light. You can respond; and as soon as you do, there is light, peace; compensation comes to you in your life, in your inner self.’

‘For every seeming loss a rose is grown in your soul garden.’

‘Women have the vision, and are beginning to take their proper place in order to bring about a more perfect balance in the world. For there comes a time when the soul has to learn and understand the law of equilibrium.’

‘When the time comes for the body to be laid aside there should be no grief. The spirit has not passed from your vision. The spirit is near you. Where there is love there is no separation. The spirit of the one left behind merges with the released spirit. The law of harmony prevails, the law of reunion and mergence.’
